



Personalised care price list for patients using donor sperm or eggs

Treatment plans and subsequent costs are tailored to each individual, and will be discussed with your specialist at initial consultation. Our dedicated patient pathway coordinators will be able to assist with all relevant paperwork, appointment bookings and payments. Please refer to our other price list for further treatment options, including surrogacy and pathology. Common questions are also answered in our FAQ section.

1. All new patients will require an initial consultation.
2. Your consultant will invoice you directly after your appointment for consultation fees.
3. A follow-up appointment is required to initiate further treatment. This appointment will need to be face-to-face if you have not been in contact with your consultant for six months or more.
4. Treatment fees must be paid in full before treatment commences. You will be contacted by the finance team to arrange payment. We reserve the right to cancel any appointment if payment has not been received in full and cleared funds.
5. Treatment will only commence when the purchased donor's gametes are safely in storage at the ACU.
6. The cost of purchasing or transporting donor gametes is not included in the treatment packages. These costs are paid directly to your chosen cryobank and courier, and are separate to the import administration fee payable to the ACU.
7. Please note some screening tests are stipulated by the Human Fertilisation & Embryology Authority (HFEA) and/or the European Union Tissue Directive (EUTD); and these are included in your package, where applicable.
8. IVF treatment may be changed to ICSI as late as the day of egg collection, if clinically indicated. The difference in cost will be charged accordingly.
9. Following an unsuccessful treatment cycle, a follow-up consultation is free of charge if booked within six weeks of a negative pregnancy test.
10. All treatment costs and packages exclude medication and cryopreservation of surplus eggs, embryos or sperm (unless stated otherwise).
11. All prices are reviewed regularly. Quotes are valid for a period of 90 days post offer, treatment must be paid in full and commenced in this timeframe. Please note, in the event that your treatment plan needs to be amended, your quoted price may change and additional fees may be charged. All changes will be discussed with you.
12. The UK Fertility regulator, the Human Fertility and Embryology Authority (HFEA) require us to pay a registration fee for some cycles. For donor IUI this fee is £37.50 and for all other treatments, this is £80. This will be included in your package where applicable.
13. If you cannot attend your consultation or scan appointment, advance notice of 24 hours is required and cancellation fees apply. More information can be found on the Refunds Information Sheet.
14. In the event of treatment cancellation, refunds may be available.

Treatment packages using donor gametes (known or partner donation)

All treatment packages include a nursing appointment, counselling, monitoring scans, an early pregnancy scan or follow-up appointment with your consultant if booked within six weeks of pregnancy test results.

Recipients of fresh egg donation with in-vitro fertilisation (IVF)

£6,050

Package includes: anaesthetic fees for sedation of donor, egg collection, sperm preparation, IVF fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate). For the recipient: preparation of the womb lining, virology screening, all necessary remaining scans and embryo transfer procedure.

Recipients of fresh egg donation with intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI) £6,950

Package includes: anaesthetic fees for sedation of donor, egg collection, sperm preparation, ICSI fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate). For the recipient: preparation of the womb lining, virology screening, all necessary remaining scans and embryo transfer procedure.

Recipients of fresh egg donation with IVF/ICSI split

£6,950

Package includes: anaesthetic fees for sedation of donor, egg collection, sperm preparation, split IVF/ICSI fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate). For the recipient: preparation of the womb lining, virology screening, all necessary remaining scans and embryo transfer procedure.

Egg thaw with intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI)

£3,200

Package includes: egg thaw, sperm preparation, ICSI fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate) and embryo transfer procedure.

In-vitro fertilisation (IVF) with donor sperm

£4,550

Package includes: anaesthetic fees for sedation, egg collection, sperm preparation, IVF fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate) and embryo transfer procedure.

Intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI) with donor sperm

£5,500

Package includes: anaesthetic fees for sedation, egg collection, sperm preparation, ICSI fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate) and embryo transfer procedure.

Intrauterine insemination (IUI) using donor sperm

£1,400

Package includes: female hormone profile (FSH, LH, E2, TSH), pre-treatment virology screening package (HepB surface, HepB core, HepC, HIV 1 & 2), AMH tests, semen preparation and one insemination.

Embryo freeze cycle with egg or sperm donation with IVF (freeze all cycle)

£4,750

Package includes: anaesthetic fees, egg collection, sperm preparation, IVF fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate), embryo freezing and up to 12 months of storage.

Embryo freeze cycle with egg or sperm donation with ICSI (freeze all cycle)

£5,700

Package includes: anaesthetic fees, egg collection, sperm preparation, ICSI fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate), embryo freezing and up to 12 months of storage.

Frozen embryo transfer (FET)

£1,750

Package includes: embryo thaw, embryo culture (where applicable) and one embryo transfer.

Medication

Medication and prescription charges are not included in package prices. Our recommended medication provider is Fertility2U who offer medication payment and delivery. We are also able to provide prescriptions if you wish to source your medication from elsewhere.

Approximate medication costs via Fertility2U are listed below:

- IVF/ICSI: **£700 - £1,200**
- FET: **£150 - £500**
- IUI: **£50 - £300**
- Ovum donation: **£1,000**

Medication for the first 12 weeks of pregnancy can be sourced from Fertility2U, your GP or privately at a cost of approximately **£150 - £800**.

Please note medication is **non-refundable and non-returnable**.

Other procedures

Ovulation induction (excluding medication)	Includes a nursing appointment, monitoring scans and an early pregnancy scan or follow-up with the doctor within six weeks of pregnancy test result.	£850
Surgical sperm retrieval (PESA/TESA)	Includes a referral for counselling if needed, anaesthetic fees, sperm preparation and freezing and up to 12 months of storage.	£1,900

Cryopreservation costs (freezing and thawing)

Egg freeze (in the event that sperm is not available on the day of egg collection)	Includes preparation of eggs for freezing, freezing process and up to 12 months of storage. (This fee is in addition to treatment package).	£800
Embryo freeze (freezing of surplus embryos)	Includes preparation of embryos for freezing, freezing process and up to 12 months of storage.	£800
Sperm freeze	Includes preparation, sample freezing and up to 12 months of storage.	£500
Annual storage fees for eggs, embryos or sperm	Payable per annum for storage, non-refundable.	£350

Import of eggs, embryos or sperm from another clinic in the UK to ACU*	£250	
Import of eggs, embryos or sperm from another clinic outside of the UK to ACU*	£450	
Export of eggs, embryos or sperm from ACU to another clinic in the UK*	£150	
Export of eggs, embryos or sperm from ACU to another clinic outside of the UK*	£250	
*Please note, this charge is administrative and does not include courier or transportation charges. The above costs do not include storage fees.		
Vitrification kit	If your gametes or embryos have previously been stored at another clinic using a vitrification system not routinely used at Guy's and St Thomas' ACU, we will need to purchase additional kit to carry out the thawing process safely. This will need to be purchased prior to your treatment starting.	£400

Occasionally, treatment cycles may need to be cancelled or postponed. In this case, refunds will be available. A charge for services already performed will be applied. Our team will be able to assist you through the refund process.
