Assisted Conception Unit

Treatment plans and the subsequent costs are tailored to each individual, and will be discussed with your specialist at initial consultation. Our dedicated patient pathway coordinators will be able to assist with all relevant paperwork, appointment bookings and payments. Please refer to our other price lists for further treatment options, including the use of a donor and surrogacy as well as pathology. Common questions are also answered in our FAQ section.

1. All new patients will require an initial consultation.
2. Your consultant will invoice you directly after your appointment for consultation fees.
3. A follow-up appointment is required to initiate further investigations and treatment. This appointment will need to be face-to-face if you have not been in contact with your consultant for six months or more.
4. Treatment fees must be paid in full before treatment commences. You will be contacted by the finance team to arrange payment. We reserve the right to cancel any appointment if payment has not been received in full and cleared funds.
5. IVF treatment may be changed to ICSI as late as the day of egg collection, if clinically indicated. The difference in cost will be charged accordingly.
6. Following an unsuccessful treatment cycle, a follow-up consultation is free of charge if booked within six weeks of a negative pregnancy test.
7. All treatment costs and packages exclude medication and cryopreservation of surplus eggs, embryos or sperm (unless stated otherwise).
8. All prices are reviewed regularly. Quotes are valid for a period of 90 days post offer – treatment must be paid in full and commenced in this timeframe. Please note, in the event that your treatment plan needs to be amended, your quoted price may change and additional fees may be charged. All changes will be discussed with you.
9. The UK fertility regulator, the Human Fertility and Embryology Authority (HFEA), require us to pay a registration fee for some cycles (£80). This will be included in your package where applicable.
10. If you cannot attend your consultation or investigation appointment, advance notice of 24 hours is required and cancellation fees apply. More information can be found on the refunds information sheet.
11. In the event of treatment cancellation, refunds may be available.

Female fertility MOT £520
60 minute consultation with your chosen consultant to understand your fertility and ability to conceive, ultrasound scan, AMH tests, lifestyle advice and report.

Male fertility MOT £400
60 minute consultation with your chosen consultant to understand your fertility and ability to conceive, semen analysis, lifestyle advice and report.

Couple fertility MOT £620
60 minute consultation with your chosen consultant to understand your fertility and ability to conceive, ultrasound scan, AMH tests, semen analysis, lifestyle advice and report.

Couple fertility MOT (same sex couple – female) £620
60 minute consultation with your chosen consultant to understand your fertility and ability to conceive, individual AMH tests, individual ultrasound scan, lifestyle advice and report.

Couple fertility MOT (same sex couple – male) £500
60 minute consultation with your chosen consultant to understand your fertility and ability to conceive, individual semen analysis, lifestyle advice and report.

Treatment packages

All treatment packages include a nursing appointment, counselling, monitoring scans, an early pregnancy scan or follow-up appointment with your consultant if booked within six weeks of pregnancy test results.

In-vitro fertilisation (IVF)

£4,550

Package includes: female hormone profile (FSH, LH, E2, TSH), pre-treatment virology screening package (HepB surface, HepB core, HepC, HIV 1 and 2), AMH tests, anaesthetic fees, egg collection, sperm preparation, IVF fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate) and embryo transfer procedure.

Intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI)

£5,500

Package includes: female hormone profile (FSH, LH, E2, TSH), pre-treatment virology screening package (HepB surface, HepB core, HepC, HIV 1 and 2), AMH tests, anaesthetic fees, egg collection, sperm preparation, ICSI fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate) and embryo transfer procedure.

IVF/ICSI split

£5,500

Package includes: female hormone profile (FSH, LH, E2, TSH), pre-treatment virology screening package (HepB surface, HepB core, HepC, HIV 1 and 2), AMH tests, anaesthetic fees, egg collection, sperm preparation, split IVF/ICSI fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate) and embryo transfer procedure.

Pre-implantation genetic testing (PGT)

£13,500

Package includes: female hormone profile (FSH, LH, E2, TSH), pre-treatment virology screening package (HepB surface, HepB core, HepC, HIV 1 and 2), anaesthetic fees, egg collection, sperm preparation, ICSI fertilisation, blastocyst culture, blastocyst biopsy, diagnostic genetic work up, genetic testing, embryo freezing, up to 12 months of storage and one frozen embryo transfer.

Intrauterine insemination (IUI)

£1,400

Package includes: female hormone profile (FSH, LH, E2, TSH), pre-treatment virology screening package (HepB surface, HepB core, HepC, HIV 1 and 2), AMH tests, semen preparation and one insemination.



Frozen embryo transfer (FET)

£1,750

Package includes: embryo thaw, embryo culture (where applicable) and one embryo transfer.

Egg freeze cycle

Package includes: female hormone profile (FSH, LH, E2, TSH), pre-treatment virology screening package (HepB surface, HepB core, HepC, HIV 1 and 2), anaesthetic fees, egg collection, preparation of eggs for freezing, egg freeze and up to 12 months of storage.

Embryo freeze with IVF (freeze all cycle)

£4,750

Package includes: female hormone profile (FSH, LH, E2, TSH), pre-treatment virology screening package (HepB surface, HepB core, HepC, HIV 1 and 2), anaesthetic fees, egg collection, sperm preparation, IVF fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate), embryo freezing and up to 12 months of storage.

Embryo freeze with ICSI (freeze all cycle)

Package includes: female hormone profile (FSH, LH, E2, TSH), pre-treatment virology screening package (HepB surface, HepB core, HepC, HIV 1 and 2), anaesthetic fees, egg collection, sperm preparation, ICSI fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate), embryo freezing and up to 12 months of storage.

Egg thaw and ICSI

£3,200

Package includes: egg thaw, sperm preparation, ICSI fertilisation, embryo culture, blastocyst culture (if appropriate) and embryo transfer procedure.



Medication

Medication and prescription charges are not included in package prices. Our recommended medication provider is Fertility2U who offer medication payment and delivery. We are also able to provide prescriptions if you wish to source your medication from elsewhere.

Approximate medication costs via Fertility2U are listed below:

- Ovulation induction: £600 – £800
- IUI: £50 – £300
- IVF/ICSI: £700 – £1,200
- FET: £150 – £500

Medication for the first 12 weeks of pregnancy can be sourced from Fertility2U, your GP or privately at a cost of approximately £150 – £800

Please note medication is non-refundable and non-returnable.

Other procedures

Ovulation induction (excluding medication)	£850

Includes a nursing appointment, monitoring scans and an early pregnancy scan or follow-up with the doctor within six weeks of pregnancy test result.

Surgical sperm retrieval (PESA/TESA)	£1,900

Includes a referral for counselling if needed, anaesthetic fees, sperm preparation and freezing and up to 12 months of storage.

Cryopreservation costs (freezing and thawing)

Egg freeze (in the event that sperm is not available on the day of egg collection)	£800

Includes preparation of eggs for freezing, freezing process and up to 12 months of storage (this fee is in addition to the treatment package).

Embryo freeze (freezing of surplus embryos)	£800

Includes preparation of embryos for freezing, freezing process and up to 12 months of storage.

Sperm freeze	£500

Includes preparation, sample freezing and up to 12 months of storage.

Annual storage fees for eggs, embryos or sperm	£350

Vitrification kit If your gametes or embryos have previously been stored at another clinic using a vitrification system not routinely used at our Assisted Conception Unit, we will need to purchase additional kit to carry out the thawing process safely. This will need to be purchased prior to your treatment starting.	£400
